Grantees

PEACE: Support in 2009 with another grant.

Grant money will go towards increasing Riviera Recicla's environmental education efforts and improving the organization's infrastructure so recycling can reach more people and businesses in each community.

Education Committee Goals

School Construction: at least two more classrooms for the Primary School in Emiliano Zapata. Remaining funds will go to more classrooms or improvement of sports facilities, kitchens and bathrooms. Scholarship Program at Costa Verde International School: continue with current scholars for the 2009/2010 school year and pending funding we would like to offer up to four more scholarships.

Smart Growth – Sustainable Development

Solve the problems that are brought to our attention by the Smart Growth Report (see Executive Summary). Punta de Mita Foundation as facilitator and distributor of information to the public and private sector regarding community issues. This will most likely take much of our attention 2009, however, it is uncertain as to how to budget for this as the Study has just been completed and still needs to be analyzed in focus groups held with the Executive Board, Advisory Board and concerned residents. Primary projects involve improving the water distribution system, accountability for the sewage treatment plant and the Plaza/Parking/Promenade/Playa project.
